

BASS COAST CAMERA CLUB-NEWSLETTER MAY/JUNE 2017

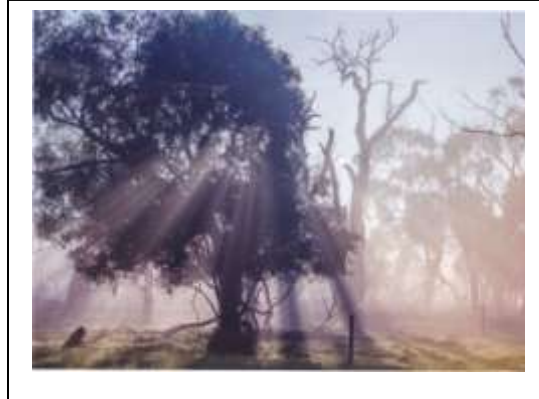
