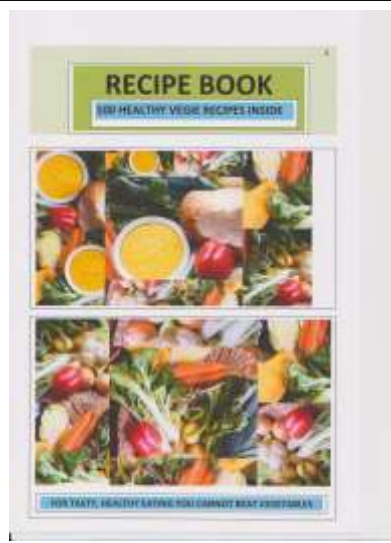


BASS COAST CAMERA CLUB-NEWSLETTER JULY/AUGUST 2017
